Some of the dogs I/we may be exposed to could be hard to handle and could cause injury even when handled with the utmost care. Location of training center: 1299 Findlay Rd, Lima, 45801

- Parking is available in front of the building and the side on Independence Rd. Extra parking for evenings/weekend classes only may use the Kenny's Auto Kare parking lot. Please do not block gate or doors.
- **Documentation** No dog will be allowed in class without this documentation:
- Proof of health records DHPP, Rabies, negative fecal check within last 3 months, Bordetella *** Last veterinary receipt should contain this information at the bottom. Application and Signed waiver. **By week of classes start** Walk-ins limited.
- Payment is due by start of classes. No refunds after first class.

Equipment: **Dogs are to be on leash at all times**, unless instructed during exercises.

- A 6ft leash leather or nylon. No Flex or retractable leashes.
- Current collar being worn. NO Harness unless veterinary note. Trainer may recommend training collar depending on your dog's training needs.
- Soft bite-size treats, something your dog really loves NO hard biscuits. This can be small bits of hot dog, chicken, turkey, liver, Bil-Jac treats, Cheerios.
- Not treat driven how about a toy.
- All training equipment is available for purchase.

Dress:

- Wear comfortable clothes/rubber soled shoes (NO FLIP FLOPS!). You will be doing a lot of walking, bending, and sitting on the floor.
- Avoid wearing loose clothing like scarfs, jewelry.
- No cell phones unless you are "on call" emergency personnel.

Pre-class:

- Exercise your dog before class. It's not fair to come to class with a dog that's had little or no exercise all day.
- Limit feed and treats before coming to class. They will be more eager to receive a treat.
- Limit petting and praise the day of class. We want your dog to seek your attention during class.
- Make sure your dog has time to take care of his bathroom needs before class. You will be responsible to pick up after your dog, inside and outside the building.

What to expect during class:

- The instructor reserves the right to expel owners or any dog that shows aggression towards people or dogs. Private lessons may be recommended in these cases. Please disclose any aggressive tendencies prior to class.
- Youth handle must be able to follow instruction and have an adult present for all classes.

- **Week one – seven**
Class work and homework
- **Week eight** graduation costume contest and games.
Optional held after class ** Star puppy and CGC testing

Homework:

- Weekly homework sheets will be sent home covering what you learned during class.
- Recommended: Research your breed. This will help you understand their behavior and assist in your training.

Absenteeism:

- If your dog is ill please do not bring them to class. You are encouraged to come so you will not get behind.
- If your non-spayed female is in heat (season) she is welcome with proper sanitary pants.
- If you are ill please call or email in absent. We will email your homework.
- You may attend another class within the same week.
